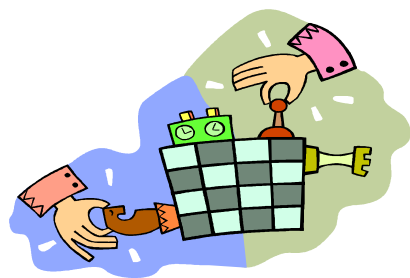

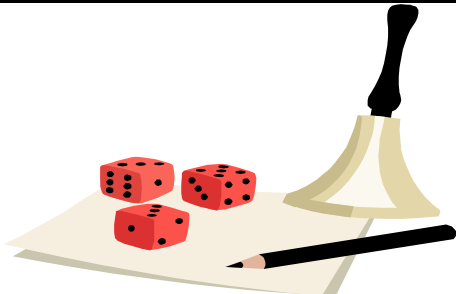

BOARD MEETING MINUTES (UNAPPROVED)  
October 21, 2015

**Call to Order** – President Steve Harenberg called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. Board Members present were Gary Smith, Cathy Doss, Bill Krokos, Matt Buczynski and Leah Allison. Absent were Brian Woertz and Bo Pratt. Also present was Glenda Carlson, Acting General Manager and Jennifer McKenzie, Manager Trainee.

**Approval of Minutes** – Gary Smith made a motion to approve the September minutes, seconded by Leah Allison. All in favor, motion carried.

**Member Resignation/New Appointed**-Cathy Doss stated that Cody Martzluf had submitted a letter of resignation to the Board. Leah Allison had made a motion to approve Cody’s resignation & appoint Jake Gelhausen-Lot 367, to finish the term. Matt Buczynski seconded it, all in favor. Motion carried. This was an email vote on September 17,2015. Cathy Doss further reported Brian Woertz had provided a proxy assigned to Gary Smith for the purpose of voting on his behalf as this meeting.
