



Minutes - Land & Lakes Committee

Wednesday, March 5, 2014

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:30. Committee members in attendance were Glenda Carlson, Collin Cochran, Glen Delorme, Lynn Gosnell, Steve Harenberg, Deb Metroff, Richard Novitsky, Bernie Sieks and Bruce Whelchel.

Report on the February 19th Board Meeting: Collin reported that the Board approved the committee's mission, goals, and members. Collin informed the Board that all projects were on hold due to the weather conditions.

Plans for Completing Erosion Control Project Number 1 (from 2013):

Discussed progress since our last committee meeting and action items for the next month or two: !) redirecting the water flow, 2) burning the wood piles, and 3) final grading and seeding. If needed, the contractor and/or committee members are available to complete the project. Glenda will advise, if the maintenance staff needs help.

Completing Work on the Lower Lake Boat Ramp: Discussed action items for the next month: 1) Repairing gap between new concrete and old black-top, and 2)maintenance of rock at lower end of new concrete. Glenda will advise as to maintenance finishing this project or if help is needed from the committee.

Dam & Bridge Inspection Reports:

- 1. Dam Inspection Report: Glenda reported that we have not yet received the report tabled until next month.
- 2. Bridge Inspection Report: Due to high cost the committee agreed that we should obtain additional professional opinion. Two committee members will pursue information through their contacts.

Last Year's Lake Treatment: Discussed the "Lake Camelot & Lancelot Annual Customer Service Review 2013" from Marine Biochemists. The Lake Camelot maintenance staff will take over the lake treatment in 2014. Greg Dennis and Dennis Woods are attending classes this week. The committee agreed that they would like Greg and/or Dennis to attend our next committee meeting to discuss what their goals and plans are for treating the lakes. Glenda will coordinate.

Erosion Control and Siltation Projects Number 1 & 2 for 2014 (The siltation ponds at the North end of Lake Camelot and the West end of Lake Lancelot):

Discussed details of proposal and recommendations (for submission to the Board at their March 19th meeting) so that we can move the projects forward as soon as weather and schedules allow. Bruce reported that over the past four months he has met, on site, with four different contractors. After going over the projects, the contractors agreed to submit time and material bids. To date, we have received three bids, of which only two are being considered. The fourth contractor has not responded to requests to submit (we think due to personal problems). The Committee agreed that our proposal should include constructing permanent work areas as well as providing access to the South side of the siltation pond on the West end of Lake Lancelot. This will save time, cost, and effort when dredging and completing other projects that need to be done in the future. The committee agreed that we should fine tune and finalize the discussed document for presentation to the Board at their March meeting. The committee directed Bruce, Collin, and Steve to fine tune our proposal and recommendation and attach to the minutes. Steve, with Collin's help, will present to the Board. The proposal I s attached.

Erosion Control and Siltation for 2014:

- 1. Removing Lake Siltation: The committee agreed that we need to start working on the following problem: Develop a plan for removing silt from the lakes. Bernie and Richard agreed to serve as a sub-committee researching the problem and will make regular reports to the committee. They were encouraged to look at multiple alternatives while brainstorming the problem.
- 2. Strategy for working with neighboring land owners (with the help of Scott Wallace and Gary Gorden from the USDA-NRCS) to control erosion into our lakes: Glenda, Deb, Steve S., with help from Bruce, will take the lead on this project and will report to the committee as they make progress.
- 3. The park access area that runs between Tewksbury and Canterbury: Bernie is still working on the areas as weather allows.
- 4. Meeting with Lake Wildwood on the methodology and equipment they use in solving their erosion and siltation problems: The committee reviewed some of the topics discussed at our last committee meeting.

New Business:

- 1. Discussed the "Fall 2013 Fish Survey Report" that we received from Rob Hilsabek. The Committee recommends following Rob's recommendations.
- 2. Glenda reported that it is once again time to attend the Illinois Lake's Management Annual Conference. The conference will be held in Sandwich Illinois. The Committee recommends that the Board approve payment for two registrations.

Next committee meeting - April 2nd

Adjournment: Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.

<u>Call to Order</u> – Vice President Brian Woertz called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm. Board Members in attendance were Steve Schmidt, Matt Buczynski, Leah Allison, Steve Harenberg, Gary Smith, and Cathy Doss; absent was board member Lynn Johnston and Bill Whitehurst. Also in attendance was Glenda Carlson, General Manager.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Steve Schmidt made the motion to approve the February 19th, 2014 meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Gary Smith. All in favor-Motion carried.

Finance Report – Leah Allison presented the Finance Report. Monthly Income and Expense statement was reviewed for February 2014.

Recognition of Members and Guests – In attendance were Collin Cochran, Jim Sinclair, Brian Emhoff, Janis Earle, Glen DeLorme, Bernie Sieks, Levi & Natasha Dinkla, Derek & Tasha Scott, Deb Metroff and Keith Johnson. Mr. Dinkla addressed the board with some concern on changes being proposed to the board on the covenants, declaration and by-laws. The Board received their packet from review committee and will be in review until the first week in May. It was suggested that an Open Discussion Forum of the Members be put together before the board makes a decision on the proposed changes. A meeting date will be announced in the future.

Committee Reports

Infrastructure – Jim Sinclair reported the committee has moved forth with gathering information for the proposed upper restroom remodeling and/ or repairs. They have received the assistance of a plumber that resides in Lake Camelot whom will be able to help them put together some cost estimates. Committee has requested board to advise Committee as to the scope of work and complete description of the project assigned.

Land and Lakes – Steve Harenberg and Collin Cochran brought a written proposal to the Board for plans and costs to dredge the siltation ponds at the west end of Lake Lancelot and the north end of Lake Camelot. After much discussion and the disclosure of three bids received, a motion was made by Gary Smith and seconded by Steve Schmidt to approve the bid from Callicotte Landscaping, Inc at a cost not-to exceed \$25,500.00. Motion approved. Collin reported on the March meeting (refer to Page 7).

Health and Environment - NO REPORT

Covenant Review – Janis Earle reported that the committee has turned its recommended changes of the declaration, by-laws and rules and regulations over to the board for their review. The board thanked the Committee for their almost two years of service and will re-convene with them and the Membership at a later date to discuss the proposals.

Security Report – Brian Emhoff reported no security issues at the clubhouse complex or RTA property over the last thirty days. Reminder- Light checks again be being performed starting April-if you're pole/yard lights is not working, please see it is repaired as early as weather permits.

Club Reports

Activities Club - Cathy Doss reported on upcoming events: Junior High Dance - Friday, March 21st,

4th of July Band/Fireworks - General Manager reported she is working with the fireworks company and has received their certificate of insurance/bonding for this year. The band is Mike and Carrie Rickey, we have paid a deposit for their services and they will be playing on the 5th from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Weather permitting, with a rain date of July 6th.

Lake Closing - Tentatively scheduled for April 1st if the ice is gone. Otherwise, as soon as weather permits.

New Business

Foth/Dam Inspection Report- Has been given to the Land and Lakes Committee for review and will be discussed by the Board at the next meeting.

Pool Chemical Bids- The General Manager reported bids to supply us with maintenance chemicals throughout the 2014 pool season are being sent out and will be available to the board at the next meeting.

The board voted to approve them to attend this conference in April 2014 at a cost not to exceed \$700.00.

Action Items – Resulting from Executive Session-

Board voted unanimously to recognize General Manager's recommendation for Leslie Murphy to assume the position of Swim Team Coordinator and an ad to be placed in the monthly newsletter for a part-time position to assist security during the summer months in the evenings and on the weekends for the 2014 season, with the understanding weekend hours will be rotated and assigned.

Adjournment – Steve Harenberg made the motion, seconded by Matt Buczynski to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 p.m. Motion carried.

We had quite the busy month in February with 40 calls in the month which is 5 more than last year and March kept emergencies going bringing our total call count for 2014 to 100. We have had quite the trend with three calls at the same time. This tends to stretch us thin but we have a good number of people responding and staging trucks at various locations allow us to cover the calls and a lot of ground in a short amount of time with no issues.

Recently we have also had to shut down a few of the roads in the area due to emergency incidents which has caused a stir in the community. This action is necessary due to the unpredictably of emergency scenes and to preserve the safety of the patients, rescue personnel, and most of all you. 
